


# Stalybridge South Ward Profile 2019




The population of Stalybridge South is just smaller than the Tameside average of 11,796 people. 62% of this population is between the ages of 16 and 64 years old, which equals the borough average.

Since 2013, the 16 to 65 years old age group has decreased by around 200 people, and the over 65 group has grown by roughly the same number of people.

The white population of Stalybridge South is 95.5%, which is more than the Tameside average of 91%, and all other major population groups make up a smaller proportion of the ward's population than on average across the borough.



## Percentage of "good passes" (grades 5+) in GCSE English and Maths



37.7% of GCSE students in Stalybridge South achieve grades 5 and above in their English and Maths qualifications, which is below the Tameside average of 40.8%.

The ward has a higher-than-average school readiness percentage, with Tameside's average value being 66%.



Stalybridge South is less deprived than the Tameside average; the IMD deprivation score for Stalybridge South is 20.3 which is less than the borough's average score of 28.8.

The proportion of children living in poverty in the ward, 24.0%, is 5.5% below the Tameside average.

On average, 70% of adults in Tameside are employed, so Stalybridge South's employment rate of 73.9% is above average for the borough, and the proportion of students is higher than the average value of 4.8%.

This map shows the deprivation rankings of the LSOAs (small areas of around 1500 people) which make up the ward. Those in decile 1 are within the top 10% deprived LSOAs in the country.




## Mean House Sale Prices



The vast majority of properties in Stalybridge South are owner occupied, with average market sale prices above the Tameside average of £139,412. The percentage of private rented homes in Stalybridge South is lower than the Tameside average of 14.2%.

10.7% of households are in fuel poverty, which is just above the average of 10.2%, however there are a below average number of homes without central heating installed; the Tameside average central heating installation percentage is 97.3%.

28.9% of the residences in Stalybridge South are semi-detached houses or bungalows, this is less than the Tameside average value of 37.5%.






## Travel Time to the Nearest GP's Surgery in minutes

Stalybridge South has more hot food takeaways and licenced premises per 1000 people than the Tameside average, and has lower-than-average travel times to the nearest GP's surgery both with and without use of a car.

There are three GP's surgeries in the ward, all of which have been rated as good or outstanding by the Care Quality Commission, which monitors healthcare practices nationally.

Stalybridge South contains three pharmacies. The area, like all of Tameside, has sufficient pharmacy access.





## Hospital Admission Rates per 100,000 people




Stalybridge South has above average hospital admission rates for children under five years old. The prevalence of childhood obesity in reception class and year six pupils is less than the Tameside average percentage.

The biggest cause of death in Stalybridge South is cancer, which is responsible for one in two of all deaths in the ward.

The male healthy life expectancy is higher than the Tameside average of 58.1 years, while the female healthy life expectancy is just below the average value of 57.6 years old.

## Childhood Obesity Percentages







## Rates of Offences per 1000 people



The total crime rate in Stalybridge South is below the Tameside average of 207.7 offences per 1000 people. Stalybridge South has a below average rate of anti-social behaviour offences, and also has a significantly lower rate of violent and sexual offences per 1000 people. Although the rate of theft offences is much lower than average, it remains the third most committed crime in the ward.

Stalybridge South has a lower-than-average rate of domestic abuse offences reported to the police compared to Tameside as a whole, but domestic abuse is the most committed crime in the area.
